REQUIRED MATERIAL:

Application Process: Each year the Purnati invites up to 12 individuals for a residency with the help of a distinguished committee representing all the creative disciplines we support. Your work is considered solely on the merit of your artist's statement and your work sample.

1. Artist's Statement: Please write *no more than 1 page (double spaced)*. Tell us about your work, yourself and your current thinking about what you would like to accomplish at Purnati. We want to learn about you as an artist and about your creative process. Please do not include information about awards, galleries, publishing etc. here. This should be listed in your Biographical Statement.

2. Biographical Statement: Please write *no more than 2 paragraphs (double spaced)*. *Here you can* list awards, exhibitions, published works etc. Please do not include this information

in your Artist's Statement.

3. Work Sample Requirements:

ACTORS/COMPOSERS/DANCERS/DIRECTORS: Submit two copies of either a tape cassette or CD. Send two hard copies of the project description.

DESIGNERS: Submit one set of four to six slides, photographs or printouts along with a corresponding list with titles and descriptions. Please mark each with your name. Slides should be in a plastic slide sheet and must be labeled with a red dot on the top right hand corner so that your work may be viewed correctly. Submit two hard copies of the project description.

FILMMAKERS/VIDEO ARTISTS: Submit two copies of your work in videocassette or CD form. Please cue your videocassettes. Duration of sample: 2 minutes maximum. Please put your name on the cassette/CD, the work title and date. Please test your cassettes to make sure they work in all machines. Submit two hard copies of the project description.

VISUAL ARTISTS including PHOTOGRAPHERS: Submit a set of four to six slides, photographs or printouts along with a corresponding list with titles, sizes, and media. Please mark each with your name. Slides should be in a plastic slide sheet and must be labeled with a red dot on the top right hand corner so that your work may be viewed correctly. Submit two hard copies of the project description.

WRITERS: Submit two copies of either a) no more than thirty pages in manuscript form, or b) up to six poems in manuscript form. Prose manuscripts must be double spaced, using a 12 pt. font. Please number your pages. Submit two hard copies of the project description.

Daily Fees The Bali Purnati Center for the Arts charges a residency fee of **US\$38** per day. Purnati does not offer any living allowance stipend. Room, board, and studio space are provided. Airfares to and from Bali and/or other transportation costs and visa requirements are the responsibility of the resident.

International Applicants

Notifications are sent via email by August 1 for Fall 2010 Season and December 1 for the Spring 2011 Season.
